GED - Pre GED Classes

GED and Pre GED classes are available to students who score at least an 6.0 or higher in reading on the TABE test. Students are placed in classes that focus on successful passing of the official GED test. Upon completion, students are entered into ACT Prep classes that prepare them for the ACT test.
