## Accomplishments:

- The MDCPS Communications Team accomplishments for July 2017
  - Launched the statewide Hot Car Safety campaign with the distribution of 10,000 "Don't Forget Me" posters that were designed in-house. This campaign was also coordinated with billboard advertising.
  - Developed marketing plan and logo for new in-home services initiative "in-CIRCLE.
  - Designed new ReNewMS website and working with MSU's NSPARC group to develop new website,
  - Produced new volunteer recruitment brochure and presentation for "Do What You Can Campaign".
- The Contracts, Procurement, and Federal Reporting Team accomplishments for July 2017
  - The Court Improvement Program has been fully transitioned.
  - The Performance Based Contract staff completed eight contract performance evaluations
