

AMENDMENT #2 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 19100103 TANF WTEP WORKFORCE TRAINING AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Amendments to the RFP are as follows:

1. Section 4.3(9) is amended to reflect the following:

Cost data: Estimate the annual cost of the service as directed in Section 4.1.8 <u>4.1.9</u> to include the required Budget Narrative and Price Estimate (Cost Estimation Worksheet). Cost data submitted at this stage is binding, but is subject to being negotiated down if your organization is chosen as a finalist. MDHS reserves the right to solicit a Best and Final Offer (BAFO) from Respondents that provided a responsible proposal but whose proposed cost exceeds MDHS' anticipated funding for the program. Respondents are encouraged to provide their best proposed cost and/or pricing in their initial response to the RFP. Should MDHS decide to exercise its right to solicit a BAFO, MDHS will provide in writing the requirements, process, and schedule for submitting a BAFO response.
