The protest must be in writing, identify the name and address of the protestor, provide appropriate identification of the procurement and resulting contract number (if known), and detail the nature of the protest, including available supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims.

The successful Respondent is instructed not to begin work, purchase materials, or enter into subcontracts relating to the project or services until execution of the contract.
